

HMS Jump Start Class Choices

***Middle School Experience - Mandatory** All students will participate in a Middle School Experience class 1st period. The purpose of the class is to familiarize students with the Hull Middle campus and lessen anxiety about attending middle school. Students will practice opening lockers and will have scavenger hunts to learn more about the campus.

Study Skills- All learning experiences are supported and enhanced by effectively incorporating good study habits and organizational skills. This program is designed to teach students how to develop these skills in order to maximize each child's learning potential.

Writing Workshop - Writing is fun! Students will learn the steps of the writing process and will complete a short story.

Reading Workshop—Students will get a head start on reading their summer novel. One novel will be chosen by the instructor and offered for sale on the first day of class at a reduced price. Students will spend the class period reading.

Math Skills with Problem Solving - The basic steps of the problem solving process will be studied, practiced, and reviewed. The main topics of the sixth grade math curriculum will be introduced. Students will be using multiple strategies that include mental math, paper and pencil calculations, calculators, and writing to describe and explain their mathematical thoughts.

Social Skills— Get to know yourself and how you can be your best! Find out how to build on your personal strengths, look at the way you communicate, and how others can see the best you. Class activities will address cooperation, communication, leadership skills, and how they will help you rise to the top of the sixth grade!

Science Inquiry- We will introduce the characteristics of Science through lab investigations. Students will conduct investigations to learn about the Scientific Method and how it is used in the sixth grade. These labs will include practice in asking questions, following procedural directions, recording data, and applying what they learn about Earth Science.

Maps, Globes, and Timelines- Discover how much fun social studies can be! This class will make their own globes, create a huge latitude and longitude map outside using markers and string, and become “researchers” who record data and create maps. To learn how to use cardinal and intermediate directions, we will go on a scavenger hunt using compasses. As a finale, students will re-search a time in history, write their own scripts, and then put on a performance for their class. Come see why social studies is truly the “social” subject area!

***Connections– Mandatory** Dabble in art, music, athletics, and technology as you explore our Connections program. In this class you will experience a sampling of the variety of popular Connections classes offered at Hull Middle School. Get ready for an exciting time.
