Summer Online Campus Tutorials to Support Math AKS

Are you interested in “jumpstarting” your child to the next grade level in Math?

Jumpstarting is an opportunity that will allow your child to begin previewing the Academic Knowledge and Skills (AKS) of the math curriculum for the upcoming school year. Your child can take advantage of this opportunity and become familiar with terms and concepts for the next grade level during the summer. This advantage could help to increase your child’s achievement rate in Math.

If you believe your child needs additional support in the Standard math curriculum or the Accelerated math curriculum from this school year, your child should take advantage of the opportunity to reinforce and review the Academic Knowledge and Skills (AKS) learned this school year. Reinforcing recently learned AKS could help your child to have a firmer mathematical foundation before moving on to the next grade level’s curriculum.

These AKS have been put into a self-paced, interactive, online tutorial. These tutorials are just an *additional support and are not required*.

The courses currently available are:

- 7th Grade Standard Math
- 7th Accelerated Math
- 8th Grade Standard Math
- Accelerated Integrated Algebra I (8th and 9th grade)

Interested? Here’s how to get your child enrolled in the tutorial course:

1. The cost is \$10/per course. Parents must complete and return the parent permission form below with payment by **May 15, 2009 to the 7th grade suite only**. Once payment has been made, your child will receive a login and a password and directions.
Note: Due to end of year deadline, payments and forms cannot be accepted after the due date.
2. The tutorials will be available for access to students from **June 1, 2009 – August 9, 2009**.
3. If you have more than one child at HMS, please be sure to complete a form for each child. If interested, you may also enroll your child in more than one course. It is \$10 per course.
4. The tutorials contain explanations, quizzes, assignments, and tests for all AKS with step by step feedback when applicable. Students can repeat any portion as many times as needed to learn the content. Although tests are graded by the computer, they do not count. These tests should be used to monitor strengths and weaknesses.

5. The tutorials are Internet-based, and can be accessed on any computer with Internet access. There is **no grade** attached to this course. There is **no “teacher”** to monitor your child’s efforts. However, directions, assignments, and examples are clear and thoroughly present the content. ***It will be up to your child and you to assure that he/she makes the best use of the resources and assignments.***
